- **Mohenjo Daro** – Indus Valley mystery city
- **Makli Necropolis** – vast ancient funerary complex
- **Balochistan Sphinx** – megalithic anomaly or natural formation?
- **Hingol National Park** – home to geomorphology and ancient pilgrimage sites
- **Ranikot Fort** – the “Great Wall of Sindh” of a lost empire?
- **Bhambore** – ancient port with Greco-Arab roots
- **Kot Diji** – pre-Harappan mound and speculative flood layers
- **Karachi** – Free Mason history and Tartarian buildings



Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1 – Welcome to Karachi: Gateway to the Past

- Meet & greet with **Cambell & Affy**
- Intro session: *"Lost Civilizations of the Indus: A Hidden Timeline"*
- Welcome Dinner
- Overnight in Karachi

Day 2 – Megaliths and Mystery: Makli & Thatta

- Explore **Makli Necropolis** – 500,000 tombs across 8km
- Decode geometric alignments and possible pre-Islamic origins
- Visit **Shah Jahan Mosque** – ancient acoustic marvel
- Overnight in Thatta

Day 3 – Bhambore: Ghost Port of the Ages

- Visit **Bhambore** – theorized as site of ancient Debal
- Examine **Greek, Hindu, and early Islamic layers**
- Discussion: *"Who Really Conquered Sindh?"*
- Return to Karachi

Day 4 – The Great Wall of Sindh, Ranikot Fort: Wall of the Ancients

- Day trip to **Ranikot Fort**
- Investigate its true age: 19th century or megalithic?
- Discussion: *"Why Was This Giant Wall Built Here?"*
- Return to Karachi or overnight in Hyderabad

Day 5 – Pilgrimage & Portals: Sehwan Sharif

- Drive to **Sehwan Sharif**
- Visit **Shrine of Lal Shahbaz Qalandar** – spiritual and magnetic site
- Group meditation & exploration of energy lines
- Overnight in Sehwan

Day 6 – Mohenjo Daro: City of the Gods?

- Full-day exploration of **Mohenjo Daro**
- Visit Great Bath, granary, grid system – advanced urbanism
- Discussion points : *"Nuclear Glass & Lost Technologies?"*
- Overnight in Larkana

Day 7 – Kot Diji: Before the Flood

- Explore **Kot Diji Fort** and underlying Indus mound
- Discussion: *"Was There a Pre-Harappan Megalithic Culture?"*
- Optional group journaling/meditation on-site
- Overnight in Larkana or Sukkur

Day 8 – Return to Karachi

- Scenic drive with discussion stops
- Evening Chill out and Dinner : *Open Forum: Ancient Pakistan & the Global Mystery Grid*
- Overnight in Karachi

Day 9 – Rest and Recuperation! – Explore Karachi

- Meet for dinner optional can also go off and do own things.

- Meditation and Yoga
- Spa day
- Explore the Markets and shopping

Affy will be at hand to share best options and give local advice

Day 10 – Into the Forbidden Zone: Hingol National Park

- Drive coastal route to **Hingol National Park – Grand Canyon of the east!**
- En route stop at **Mud Volcanoes** – ancient sacred sites?
- Introduction to **geomythological formations /pre flood world**
- Overnight glamping or eco-stay at Kund Malir

Day 11 – Hingol: Temples, Serpents & Star Maps

- Explore **Hinglaj Mata Cave Temple**
- Visit **Princess of Hope** & discuss possible Atlantean links
- Speculative geomapping: **Ley lines & star alignments**
- Overnight in Hingol/Kund Malir

Day 12 – The Sphinx of Balochistan: Natural or Ancient?

- Visit the **Balochistan Sphinx & Lion Formations**
- Ground discussion: *"Erosion vs Architecture: What Do You See?"*
- Filming opportunity with Cambell
- Return to base for overnight

Day 13 – Gadani & Ancient Coastal Port Theory

- Visit **Gadani coast** – ancient trade links, energy grid ideas
- Observe ship-breaking yards – modern ruins juxtaposed with ancient speculation

- Return to Karachi

Day 13 – Rest and Recuperate – FREE DAY!

Optional Site: Chaukhandi Tombs / Free Exploration

- Visit **Chaukhandi Tombs** – unexplained megalithic-style carvings, or much recent?
- Option for small group deep-dive discussions or rest day
- Farewell dinner & wrap-up session with Affy & Cambell

Day 14 – Departure

- Airport transfers
- Optional Breakfast hang out.
